About this Policy

This policy explains when and why the GKOC collect personal information about our members, how we use it, how we keep it secure and your rights in relation to it.

We may collect, use and store your personal data, as described in this Data Privacy Policy and as described when we collect the data from you.

We reserve the right to amend this Data Privacy Policy from time to time without prior notice. You are advised to check our website www.gordonkeeble.org.uk regularly for any amendments. No amendments will be made retrospectively.

We will always comply with the General Data Protection Rules (GDPR) when dealing with your personal data. Further details on the GDPR can be found at the website of the Information Commissioner www.ico.gov.uk.

How we protect your personal data

We have implemented a generally accepted standard of technological and operational security in order to protect personal data from loss, misuse or unauthorised alteration or destruction.

Please note however where you are transmitting your information to us over the internet we cannot guarantee this to be 100% secure.

We will notify you promptly in the event of any breach of data which might expose you to serious risk.

Who else has access to the information you provide us with?

We will never sell your personal data. We will not share your personal data with any Third Party without your prior consent (which you are free to withhold) except where required to do so by law or as set out in the table above.

We may pass your personal data to Third Parties who are our services providers, agents or subcontractors for the purposes of completing tasks and providing services to you on our behalf (e.g. the printers for group mailings). However, we disclose only the personal data necessary for the Third Party to deliver the service and we require they keep your information secure and not to use it for their own purposes.

How long do we keep your information?

We will keep your personal data on our system for as long as you are a member and as long afterwards as is necessary to comply with our legal obligations and legitimate interests in the running of the club.

We will review your personal data every year to establish whether we are still entitled to process it. If we decide we are not entitled to do so we will retain your personal data in archived form for the requisite period to comply with any legal obligations (e.g. compliance with tax regulations, defence of any legal claims and the like). Thereafter all personal data will be securely destroyed.

We will securely destroy any financial information immediately it is no longer needed.

Your rights

You have rights under the GDPR:

- To access your personal data
- To be provided with information about how your personal data is processed
- To have your personal data corrected
- To have your personal data erased in certain circumstances
- To object to or restrict how your personal data is processed
- To have your personal data transferred to yourself or to another in certain circumstances
